Request for information

Request received 13 September 2023:

"I have seen on the internet that the ICO approved BCRs for American Express on 29 October 2012 which have been in effect as of 28 January 2013. Is there a way on your website to view them? Unfortunately, so far I have not been able to find the version of 2012. If there is not, is there any way that you can send me the 2012 version of the BCRs that you authorized at that time?"

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA). As you are aware, this legislation provides public access to recorded information held by a public authority unless an appropriate exemption applies.

Our response

We do not hold any information in scope of this request.

We do not hold a copy of the American Express EU Binding Corporate Rules (BCRs) as authorised on 29 October 2012, and we do not publish them on our website. BCR holders, however, are required to make their BCRs available to data subjects.
