You asked us:

"I would like to request the following information

1) recorded information showing the date on which the ICO's reprimand on Gain Capital Ltd was published on the ICO's website. I assume that the ICO will have electronic data from the website itself showing the change.

2) recorded information about the publication date of the reprimand including why that date was chosen."

We received your request on 12 May 2023

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

Firstly, I would like to apologise again for the delay in responding to this request.

I have consulted with the relevant departments and asked if we have information in scope of this request.

I can confirm that the date and time of publication 12pm on 5 April 2023.

We do not hold any information relating why this date was chosen. There is an email stating that the reprimand needs to be published on the website, but there is no information about the need to publish it on a particular date.

This concludes our response.
