You asked us:

Our understanding is that the PSNI have self-reported to the ICO in relation to the purported breach. Please see correspondence to our client from the PSNI attached.

We would be grateful if you could confirm whether the PSNI have reported this matter to the ICO, and if so, please let us know the outcome of your investigations.

If this matter has not been reported by the PSNI, please let us know and we shall proceed to make a complaint ourselves.

We received your request on 25 July 2023.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

I can confirm this incident has been reported to the ICO and our investigation is ongoing.

As our investigation is ongoing, we do not yet hold information relating to the outcome. Any requests received for details of ongoing investigations are likely to be exempt from disclosure.
