## Request

"The ICO has published an approach to performing transfer risk assessments (TRAs) for organisations relying on GDPR Article 46. It is based on assessing human rights risks. The ICO approach is quite different from the EDPB's approach, which is based on assessing local laws and practices. I would like to know any views expressed by any EU data protection regulators about the ICO's approach to TRAs, particularly whether those regulators agree or disagree as to whether the ICO's approach is a valid way of complying with Article 46 of the GDPR in light of the Schrems II judgment."

Your request, received on 3 July 2023, has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).
