*"I'm looking for information about a company that could have paid a gdpr fine between 2018-2021. The company name was Melza Ltd, the trading name was Lindy Bop , the directors name was Mr Dylan Cross."*

We received your request on 23 June 2023.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

## Our response

We have searched our records based on the information you have provided. We can confirm that we do not hold any information in relation to fines issued by the ICO to Melza Ltd/Lindy Bop.
