Request

You asked us:

"We are aware that London Borough of Hackney Council have reported the data breach to the ICO [on or around November/December 2020].

As such, we would appreciate if you could provide a copy of your concluded investigations in relation to this matter".

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

We have searched our case management records based upon the information you have provided and can confirm that we do not hold any information falling within the scope of your request.

This is because our investigation into the personal data breach reported by London Borough of Hackney Council is ongoing and there is currently no outcome.
