Review of response to information request

I write further to your email of 27 October 2023 in which you requested a review of the handling of your information request.

You are questioning whether we have provided all the requested information. Specifically, you would like to know whether any additional audio/visual information is held in relation to the e-learning module and blog. You have asked for a copy of the e-learning module.

The purpose of an internal review is to look again at your request, at our response, and to check that any exemptions applied were appropriate. I am a Senior Information Access Officer in the Information Access Team and I have had no prior involvement in the handling of your request.

Review

I can confirm that the blog was published alongside two images. The first image is a corporate photograph of the author, and the second is a logo of the Children's code.

However, given that these images do not add any context to the requested information – microaggressions and unconscious bias – I do not find that they are in scope of your request. I do not uphold this element of your complaint.

You may wish to make a separate request for these images, however the author's image is personal data and would be withheld under section 40(2) of the FOIA. You can find the Children's code logo at the bottom of [this page](#).

I have reviewed the e-learning module and can confirm that no additional audio-visual material was included. I therefore do not uphold this element of your request.

Please note that the FOIA entitles the requester to a copy of information held by a public authority, rather than copies of documents. I find that it was appropriate to provide you with a copy of the module script and that

this contained all the information in scope of your request. I do not uphold this aspect of your complaint.

This concludes my review.
