## **Request for information**

Request received 11 November 2023:

"Please let me know whether the local ICO. conducted proceedings against Avast Software s.r.o., whose registered office is located at 1737/1A Pikrtova, Prague 4, Czech Republic? There is information on the Internet that citizens have taken Avast to court over the suspected sale of personal data and disclosures about the leak of personal data of European Union citizens.

Please indicate what action the ICO. in relation to the disclosure of data from Avast and the breach of the European Union and Council Data Protection Regulation?"

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA). This legislation provides public access to recorded information held by a public authority unless an appropriate exemption applies.

### Our response

We do not hold any information in scope of this request. We have searched our complaint and investigation casework management systems, and have consulted with our international and intelligence teams.

As you note, the registered office for Avast is in the Czech Republic, and thus the regulatory authority is the Czech Republic Office for Personal Data Protection, not the ICO.

It may also be helpful to note that <u>Enforcement action</u> the ICO takes is detailed on our website. We have also published information about <u>Our international work</u> and how we work with other regulatory authorities in different countries on our website.



This concludes our response to your request.
