Request

On 28 November 2023, you stated to us: *"I am hoping to get the details of all issues raised with the Information Commissioner Office in relation to Presbyterian Church in Ireland in the last 10 years."*

On 28 November 2023, the ICO contacted you for clarification about your request as the word 'details' could be interpreted in different ways.

You responded, on 29 November 2023, with the following *"Can I get the list of the cases you hold, case summarise, any fines linked to the cases and the reason for the fine please."*

We have understood 'case summarise' to be an accidental typing error and to actually be a request for case summaries.

We received your request on 29 November 2023 as this was the date we received your clarification.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

Please find attached a spreadsheet which provides a summary of four of the cases we hold.

We can confirm that we also hold a case about the Presbyterian Church in Ireland Council for Social Witness. We are advising you about this as online research indicates this to be a 'branch' of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, however, it is a separate data controller. Should you wish to obtain the details of this case, you will need to submit a new request to the ICO.
