Request

"Is the Conservative Club's registration to their CCTV usage?

Could you kindly provide me their CCTV usage impact assessment?"

We received your request on 10 November 2023.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

We understand that your request relates to the St Asaph Conservative Club.

We do not hold information within the scope of your request.

Businesses who process personal data are required to register with the ICO. This will include businesses using CCTV. For each registration, we require details of the sector, subsector and the nature of the work of the business. However, the registration form does not require businesses to specifically identify the manner in which they process personal data, or their reason for registration, such as the use of CCTV.

We do not hold a Data Protection Impact Assessment (DPIA) for St Asaph Conservative Club.

Under Article 36 of the UK GDPR, we receive DPIAs from data controllers for the purposes of prior consultation before data processing starts, however, we do not hold information of this nature from St Asaph Conservative Club.

This concludes our response to your information request.
