You asked us:

*"For South Yorkshire Police... was this data breach reported to the ICO??*

*and*

*copy of the data breach rules the ICO have in place for the Police."*

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

## Our response

I have searched our casework management system based on the information provided in your email and I was unable to find recorded information of the breach having been reported to the ICO. It is also important to note that not all data breaches are reportable to the ICO.

I can also confirm that the process and guidelines for data breach reporting is the same for all data controllers regardless of the sector, and as such there is no information held for specific sectors. Further information can be on our website here: [Report a breach | ICO](#).
