We received your request on 26 March 2024.

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

### Our response

We do hold information within the scope of your request.

A data breach was reported to the ICO by The University of Wolverhampton on 22 February 2024 and was dealt with under case reference IC-290372-V0R3. Our investigations into this matter have now concluded with an outcome of no further action.
