Request for information

Request received 19 April 2024:

"Please can you confirm if the Met Office reported the alleged GDPR breaches to the ICO in December 2021, May 2022 and April 2024?"

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA). This legislation provides public access to recorded information held by a public authority unless an appropriate exemption applies.

Our response

We do not hold information in scope of your request. We searched our casework management system but did not find a personal data breach (PDB) report matching the details you provided.

Further information

Please be aware that due to the ICO <u>Retention and Disposal Policy</u>, we do not hold casework records indefinitely.

You should also be aware that not every PDB is reportable to the ICO. In the event of a breach, an organisation must assess the risk to the individual(s) affected. We have guidance online for when and how to Report a breach.

We may also have provided advice to data controllers by telephone to assist them with breach incidents. These calls are not recorded.

If you or another individual has been affected by a data breach and wish to raise a complaint with us, you can do so via the <u>Data protection and personal information complaints tool</u> on our website.



We publish details of <u>Personal data breach cases</u> reported to us in our <u>Complaints and concerns data sets</u>. Some more serious PDBs are referred to our investigations department, and these are shown in the relevant investigations datasets.

This concludes our response to your request.

Next steps

You can ask us to review our response. Please let us know in writing within 40 working days if you want us to carry out a review.

If we perform a review but you are still dissatisfied, you can <u>raise a complaint</u> to the ICO as regulator of the FOIA. This complaint will be handled just like a complaint made to the ICO about any other public authority.
