Request

You asked us: "*...Was there a conclusion/ruling to the above complaint [IC-108170-P1J8], if so, is this something you could share...?*"

We received your request on 16 August 2024.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

Having searched our records, we can confirm that we hold information in the scope of your request.

Please find attached a copy of the outcome letter for the above complaint.

You will see that personal data has been redacted in our response. It is exempt under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Disclosure of this data would break the first principle of data protection - that personal data is processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.

There is no strong legitimate interest that would override the prejudice that disclosure would cause to the rights and freedoms of the individuals concerned. As such, we are withholding the information under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

This concludes our response.
