

## Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

### Request:

The complainant requested the following information from the London Borough of Haringey Council on 11 June 2024:

- "1) Can you please give me a list of all the voided/empty 3 and 4 bedroom council homes in the Haringey area including their postcodes not full address owned by Haringey.
- 2) Can you please list the 3 and 4 bedroom voided/empty properties that are out of borough properties owned by Haringey with their post codes not full address.
- 3) Can you please list 3 and 4 bedroom properties that Haringey council have purchased, with the properties postcodes not full address.
- 4) Can you please tell me how much 3 and 4 bedroom properties in haringey that are and will come available this year 2024 with their postcodes not full address
- 5) Without disclosing personal data can you please tell me how much people were offered a direct let into Permanent council home that were 3

and 4 bedroom properties in 2022,2023, and up until june 2024. with their postcodes not full address.”

**Commissioner’s Decision:**

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the Commissioner, by the date of this notice the public authority has not issued a substantive response to this request. Therefore the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

**Steps:**

The public authority must provide a substantive response to the request in accordance with its obligations under FOIA.

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

**Right of Appeal:**

Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from:
