Request:

The complainant requested the following information from London Borough of Haringey on 12 June 2024:

1. Please confirm the number of reports Haringey LBC received of anti-social behaviour perpetrated by an individual against a neighbour ("neighbour ASB") per year from 2015 to date.
2. In respect of the reports of neighbour ASB in (1), please confirm the ethnicity of both the alleged perpetrators and victims of the neighbour ASB (if known) per year from 2015 to date.
3. In respect of the reports of neighbour ASB in (1), please confirm how many of the incidents of neighbour ASB were hate-related and the basis of the hate-related ASB (e.g. whether the ASB was due to disability, sexuality, race, sex etc) if known per year from 2015 to date.
4. In respect of the reports of neighbour ASB in (1), whether any further action was deemed necessary and the outcome of the reports/any further action per year from 2015 to date.

Commissioner's Decision:

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the

Commissioner, by the date of this notice the public authority has not issued a substantive response to this request. Therefore the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

Steps:

The public authority must provide a substantive response to the request in accordance with its obligations under FOIA.

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

Right of Appeal:

Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from:
