## Request

You asked us:

"Please provide the following details regarding ICO investigations into Surrey Police from January 1, 2020, to the present:

- 1. The total number of complaints received by the ICO regarding Surrey Police's handling of:
- -Subject Access Requests (SARs)
- -Data retention issues
- -Evidence tampering or metadata alteration
- -Breach of GDPR/Data Protection Act 2018
- -Failure to provide data under FOIA or DPA requests
- 2. The outcomes of these complaints, including:
- -How many resulted in ICO enforcement action.
- -Whether any formal reprimands, fines, or corrective orders were issued.
- -Any general trends of non-compliance identified by the ICO.
- 3. Copies of any internal ICO reports, audits, or correspondence related to these issues."

We received your request on 15 February 2025.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

### Our response

We confirm that we hold information in scope of your request.



The ICO retains casework inline with our <u>retention policy</u>. In most cases, complaints are automatically deleted after 2 years of inactivity on the case. We therefore do not hold the information that you have requested going back to 2020.
