1. Request:

The complainant requested the following information from Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust on 6 August 2024:

"I am making a Freedom of Information Request for both ICD10 first/Primary diagnosis discharge codes and cases, and OPCS4 primary procedure codes and cases, recorded per individual hospital in your health authority. I hope you can help me with obtaining the following data. Any information must be totally anonymised; however, I am requesting the name or the postcode of each hospital as it pertains to the data set.

I am requesting the data for the last five calendar years, i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23.

The suggested data format is in columns:

1. Hospital name or postcode

2. Primary diagnosis ICD-10 3/4 or 5 digits (The ICD 10 data comprises the range A000 to Q999)
3. Number of cases
4. Years

The other data set deals with procedures/surgery:

1. Hospital name or postcode
2. OPCS4: Primary procedure to 4 or more digits
3. Number of cases
4. Years"

2. Commissioner's Decision:

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the Commissioner, by the date of this notice the public authority has not issued a substantive response to this request. Therefore, the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

3. Steps:

The public authority must provide a substantive response to the request in accordance with its obligations under FOIA.

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

4. Right of Appeal:

Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from:
