1. Request and Response:

The complainant made a request for information on 25 October 2024. Suffolk Constabulary acknowledged the complainant request on the same date, and allocated the reference FOI 003920/24 to it.

Suffolk Constabulary provided a valid response on 10 January 2025.

2. Commissioner's Decision:

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the Commissioner, the public authority did not provide a valid response within the statutory time frame. Therefore the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

3. Right of Appeal:
