A comprehensive list detailing every occasion since the outsourcing of refuse and recycling collection services to Kier and then Plan B, where collection was delayed. For each instance of delay, please provide the following details:

Date of scheduled collection

Date of actual collection

Reason for the delay

Details of the contractual agreements between Bridgend County Borough Council and both Kier and Plan B. In particular, I am interested in the provisions regarding penalties for failed collections. Reference: IC-363682-T5S5



Please provide copies of relevant sections of the contract outlining these penalties.

Information regarding any penalties imposed on Kier and Plan B due to failed collections, including:

Dates of penalty imposition

Amount of penalties

Total amount of penalties paid to date by each company"

Commissioner's Decision:

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the Commissioner, by the date of this notice the public authority has not issued a substantive response to this request. Therefore the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

Steps:

The public authority must provide a substantive response to the request in accordance with its obligations under FOIA.

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.
