ANPR letters, response and FOI request

DfT draft response is still awaiting ministerial approval but has been flagged as urgent. Minister has been busy this week travelling to US and attending COP28.

DB explained that in addition to the letter from Prof Sampson, the ICO has also received three separate letters from Tony Porter since July, and most recently a FOI request.

ICO's FOI team is currently processing the request, including determining which documents will be within scope. DB flagged that emails with DfT, including recent ones with EM may be within scope.

DB indicated that the ICO is planning to respond to the letters alongside the FOI response. DB noted that the ICO response is still being developed, but is likely to acknowledge the areas of concerns while confirming that the ICO does not yet have a set policy position on this area and is currently prioritising other areas of concern.

EM will endeavour to get response signed off before ICO respond to letters and prior to the FOI deadline. DB noted that the timescales around this may influence some of the content of the ICO's response eg could reference DfT's response in ICO response if letter signed off in time, but if not could allude to DfT's intent to respond, as well as the ICO's engagement with DfT on this matter.
