We welcome the fact that this change was subsequently made and we will be looking closely at the inquiries recommendations in this space and any implications it may have for our work. In the meantime, we continue to consider individual complaints relating to information that may be found in these channels to ensure that we are satisfied that sufficient searches have been made to locate and consider information that may be relevant to a request.
