# Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR) Decision notice

### **Decision (including any steps ordered)**

- 1. The complainant requested information from the Royal Borough of Greenwich (the public authority) in the form of correspondence about the ULEZ scrappage scheme.
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the above public authority breached regulation 5(2) of the EIR by failing to provide a valid response to the request within the statutory time frame of 20 working days.
- 3. The Commissioner does not require further steps to be taken.

#### **Request and response**

4. On 1 June 2023, the complainant made the following request for information to the public authority:

"Could you please send me all correspondence between members/councillors and the Greater London Authority/Transport for London about the ULEZ scrappage scheme, sent between Monday 22 May and noon on Thursday 1 June."

- 5. The public authority responded on 18 August 2023.
- 6. The complainant has confirmed that they are happy with the information they have now received, but wish to have the late response formally recorded.

#### Reasons for decision

7. Regulation 5(1) of the EIR states that:

"a public authority that holds environmental information shall make it available on request."

8. Regulation 5(2) of the EIR states that:

"Information shall be made available under paragraph (1) as soon as possible and no later than 20 working days after the date of receipt of the request."

9. From the evidence provided to the Commissioner in this case, it is clear that the public authority did not deal with the request for information in accordance with the EIR. The Commissioner's decision is that the public authority has breached regulation 5(2) by failing to respond to the request within 20 working days.
