You asked us:

Please include only flights that took place from 1 January 2024 to today and that were conducted in business or first class.

For each flight, please provide: date, class, destination, expenditure, purpose of the trip, and justification for flying in business or first class."

We received your request on 29 March 2025.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

We do not hold any information which falls within the scope of your request.

This is because the Commissioner has not undertaken any flights in business class or first class, at a cost to the ICO, during the time period you requested.
