- Has an investigation into Oracle Corporation's GDPR violations been formally opened by the UK ICO?
- If so, please confirm the scope and timeline for regulatory action.

2. **Application of GDPR Enforcement Powers:**

- Is the UK ICO actively exercising its enforcement authority to investigate and hold Oracle accountable for endangering UK citizens' data privacy and security?

3. **Transparency of the Process:**

- When can I expect updates on the ICO's findings and any potential actions being taken?
